Darrell Franzen presented a letter (02/28/2021) on behalf of several Collegeport area farmers with concerns of drainage issues. He is asking that this be looked at (letter attached).

Steven Goertz from Nature Conservancy in Collegeport then asked why he is being asked to split the cost now to install a pipe when in 2015 they paid the cost of the entire pipe. He was upset and felt DD3 was not following cost sharing agreement in the Work Order Request Form. Homer Aparicio advised him that Bill Miller will look into this further and would contact him to discuss the cost sharing arrangement. Homer also advised him that normally the landowner pays for the cost of the pipe and DD3 would put them in but he does not recall what the arrangement was for the pipe that was installed in 2015.


