

**RECORD OF THE MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS  
OF MATAGORDA COUNTY DRAINAGE DISTRICT NO. 3, HELD ON  
September 26, 2022**

Pursuant to notice given, the Commissioners of Matagorda County Drainage District No. 3 met at 7:00 p.m. at the District office located at 807 Henderson, Palacios, Texas.

Those present at said meeting were: Homer Aparicio, Jr., Jeremy Hunt, Tommy Corporon, Bill Miller and Isidro Castanon.

Minutes of September 26, 2022 were read and approved on motion by Homer Aparicio, Jr. and second by Tommy Corporon.

On motion by Jeremy Hunt and second by Homer Aparicio, Jr. the following bills were approved unanimously. (See Attached.)

On motion by Homer Aparicio, Jr. and second by Jeremy Hunt a General Group Category Budget for 2023 was presented for adoption. All voted in favor and the motion passed. The Budget is attached.

On motion by Homer Aparicio, Jr. and second by Jeremy Hunt, a motion to adopt a resolution setting a tax rate that exceeds the no-new-revenue tax rate was presented for adoption. Homer Aparicio, Jr. moved that the property tax rate be increased by the adoption of a tax rate of .02460, which is effectively a 3.71 percent increase in the tax rate.


“THE TAX RATE WILL EFFECTIVELY BE RAISED BY 3.71 PERCENT AND WILL RAISE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS ON A \$100,000 HOME BY APPROXIMATELY \$.88.

All voted in favor of the resolution to adopt the tax rate for 2022 and the resolution passed. A copy of the resolution is attached.

Motion by Homer Aparicio and second by Tommy Corporon the receipt of the August 2022 Financial Report and August 2022 and 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter Investment Reports were acknowledged and approved.

Miller’s Report – The receipt of Bill Miller’s Report was acknowledged and all new jobs and application forms in Miller’s Report were approved on Motion by Homer Aparicio, Jr. and second by Jeremy Hunt. (See Attached Report)

There was no further business to come before the commissioners. On motion made by Tommy Corporon and second by Homer Aparicio, Jr. and passed unanimously, the meeting was adjourned at 7:55 PM.
